The EWEB Child Development Center is looking for qualified substitute teachers. We are a high quality, non-profit child care center located in downtown Eugene. We serve 56 children ages 8 weeks-6 years old. Our mission is to provide a warm, safe, and healthy environment where everyone is accepted and respected, and growth and learning are nurtured.

General Duties:

The substitute teacher, under the supervision of the lead classroom teacher, is responsible for the physical and emotional well-being of the children in her/his care. This includes the emotional, cognitive, social, and safety needs of children ages 2 months to 6 years. The substitute teacher is expected to adhere to and enhance the policies and philosophy of EWEB Child Development Center (EWEB CDC) as described in the Employee Handbook.

Necessary Requirements:

Enrollment in the Oregon Central Background Registry and a minimum of one year of experience in a licensed child care center is preferred. You must also have, or be willing to obtain, your CPR/First Aid card, Food Handlers card, attend an ORO approved class in recognizing and reporting child abuse and neglect, and attend an online introduction to child care health and safety training.
